

## SEPTEMBER 2007 Monthly Meeting Minutes

Meeting: September 11th, 2007

- -GEORGE T. QUESTIONED WHAT HAS BEEN DONE ON AN AUDIT. GREGG MILLER SAID THE AUDIT WILL BE DONE BY THE END OF THE YEAR.
- -GEORGE SUGGESTED WE GO AHEAD AND GIVE \$25.00 TO THE GROUPS WHO STAYED FOR THE SUNDAY SHOW AND THE ALTOONA TRAIN COLLECTORS ASSOCIATION. THE INDIVIDUALS WHO OPENED THEIR HOMES FOR LAYOUT TOURS WILL ALSO BE COMPENSATED.
