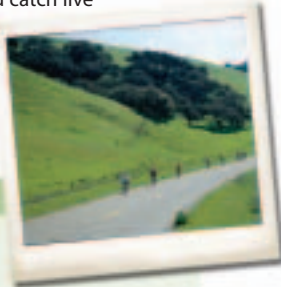


62. Experience a classic Santa Barbara courtyard at the **La Arcada Shopping Center**; 1100 block of State and Figueroa Streets.

69. Relish in the night life on **State Street** and catch live music in bars and nightclubs.
70. Join the **Santa Barbara Music Club** in the Faulkner Gallery of the downtown Public Library for concerts; 40 E. Anapamu St. *Every third Wed. at 5pm and Sat. at 3pm.*



THE GREAT OUTDOORS

71. **Barbeque** at one of Santa Barbara's parks or beaches. 805.564.5418
72. Watch the moon set into the Pacific at **Mesa Lane Beach** a.k.a. Thousand Step Beach; Mesa Ln.
73. Play **tennis** at one of the numerous public courts. 805.564.5418
74. Pitch horseshoes at **Oak Park**; 401 Shoreline Dr. 805.966.6110
75. Splash around in **Oak Park's Wading Pool**.
76. Fish off of **Stearns Wharf**, the oldest working pier in California.
77. Go tide pooling at rocky areas off **Carpinteria State Beach, Leadbetter Beach** (below Shoreline Park), and **Arroyo Burro Beach**.
78. Bring your board and surf Santa Barbara's well-known surf spots. Beginners paddle out at **Leadbetter Point** off Cabrillo Blvd., and advanced surfers take 101 South and exit Bates St. to surf **Rincon**.
79. Check out the great views, nature trails, and War Memorial at **Elings Park** in the hills above Las Positas Rd.
80. Run bleachers or jog the track at **Santa Barbara City College** and enjoy a beautiful ocean view.
81. Rollerblade, bike, or stroll the 3-mile waterfront path beginning at the Harbor.
82. Participate in novice-to-expert volleyball pick-up games at **East Beach** on Cabrillo Blvd. 805.965.0509
83. Play **Frisbee Golf** on the 6700 block of Sueno in Isla Vista.
84. Spy rare birds in the marsh area by **Sands Beach** in Isla Vista.
85. Shoot hoops at **Santa Barbara High School's** outdoor courts.
86. Walk the trail along **Lake Los Carneros**, a picturesque park in Goleta.

17. Dip your fingers into the **dolphin fountain** at the foot of Stearns Wharf; Cabrillo Blvd. at State St.
18. Tip your hat to **King Carlos** in the El Presidio on Canon Perdido St.
19. Visit the **Rainbow Arch** on Cabrillo Blvd., near East Beach, and admire its bright colored arches against the ocean backdrop.
20. View 75 murals throughout the city of **Lompoc**. Mural maps available. 805.736.4567
21. Admire the Indian heroine **Sacagawea**, whose statue resides at the corner of State and Victoria Streets.



HISTORICAL LANDMARKS & ARCHITECTURAL INTERESTS

22. Don't miss the panoramic view from the 85-foot tower of the **Santa Barbara County Courthouse**! 805.962.6464
23. Relive Santa Barbara's Spanish heritage at **El Presidio**, a Spanish-built fort founded in 1782; 123 E. Canon Perdido St. 805.966.9719
24. Stroll through the historic courtyard and window shop the boutiques of **El Paseo**, "Street in Spain"; De La Guerra St.
25. Browse for antiques while viewing splendid **Victorian houses** on Brinkerhoff Ave. in downtown Santa Barbara.
26. Tour the picturesque campus of **UCSB** and don't miss the bird's eye view from **Storke Tower**; Goleta. 805.893.8175
27. Tour **Westmont College** campus, located off of Sycamore Canyon Rd. in Montecito. 805.565.6000
28. Walk the picturesque grounds of the **Vedanta Temple** and see the award-winning structure designed by architect Lutha Maria Riggs; 927 Ladera Ln., Montecito. 805.969.2903
29. Take the **Red Tile Walking Tour**, a 12-block journey through historic downtown. *Maps available at the Visitor Center & Courthouse.*
30. Visit **Stow House**, the oldest frame house in Goleta built in 1872; 304 Los Carneros Rd. *Open weekends 2–4pm; small donation suggested*. 805.964.4407
31. See the **Moreton Bay Fig Tree**. Planted in 1877, it is the oldest of its kind in the nation, with a 21,000 square foot area of shade; Chapala St. at Montecito St.
32. Pull up to the historic stage coach stop **Cold Springs Tavern** for drinks or a meal; San Marcos Pass/Hwy. 154. 805.967.0066
33. Visit the historical **Painted Caves** of the Chumash Indians; Painted Cave Rd. 805.733.3713
34. Visit historic **Casa De La Guerra**, where the city held its first official meeting in 1875; located across from De La Guerra Plaza.

FLORA & FAUNA

35. Enjoy the view and stroll the trails at **Franceschi Park**; 1510 Mission Ridge Rd.
36. Investigate **Cabrillo Point** and the **Demonstration Gardens** on the Santa Barbara City College campus. 805.965.0581
37. Enjoy the splendor of over 100 varieties of orchids at the **Santa Barbara Orchid Estate**; 1250 Orchid Dr. 805.967.1284
38. Admire roses at the **Rose Garden** across the street from the Mission.
39. Take Highway 1 to catch the splendor of the colorful **Lompoc Flower Fields**. *In bloom May–Sep*. 805.736.4567
40. Delight your senses with the beauty of lavender at **Clairmont Lavender Farm**; 2480 Roblar Ave., Los Olivos. *In bloom Jun.–Jul*. 805.688.7505



ANIMAL INSTINCTS

41. View the birds at the **Andree Clark Bird Refuge**; 1400 E. Cabrillo Blvd.
42. Watch for Pacific Gray whales (*Jan.–Mar.*) and Blue and Humpback whales (*Jun.–Aug.*) spouting, breaching, and smacking their tails on the water. The best viewing spot from land is at the statue of the bronze whale tail at **Shoreline Park**.
43. See turtles sunning themselves on rocks, koi swimming in ponds, and beautiful flowers at the **Alice Keck Park Memorial Gardens**; 1500 block of Santa Barbara St.
44. Admire monarch butterflies in their natural habitat in the Ellwood area north of Goleta. *Seasonal in the winter months*.
45. Learn about marine wildlife at the **Gaviota Coast Conservancy**. 805.683.6631
46. View eagles at Lake Cachuma and in the Santa Ynez Valley from vista points along Hwy. 154.
47. Touch the marine life in the tanks at the **UCSB Marine Lab** next to the Lagoon. Call 805.893.8765 for reservations.

GENERAL SIGHTS

48. Spend time at the beach, bask in the sunshine, walk barefoot in the sand, or take a dip in the Pacific.
49. Visit the **Outdoor Visitors Center** on the Harbor where you can view the gorgeous sights of the Channel Islands, downtown Santa Barbara, and the Los Padres National Forest.
50. Picnic in the park and explore **Nojoqui Falls**; Alisal Rd. near Solvang.
51. Conjure images of old Denmark via Danish architecture and authentic foods in **Solvang**.
52. Bring the children to **Kidsworld** in Alameda Park where they can enjoy hours of fun and entertainment; 1400 Santa Barbara St.
53. Enjoy the waterfront's novelty stores, restaurants, and marine shops, great for boaters and land lovers alike; **Stearns Wharf & the Harbor**, along Cabrillo Blvd. 805.897.1962
54. Visit the Harbor for a self-guided **Fish-Walk Tour** featuring interpretive plaques detailing the history of the harbor's commercial fishing industry.
55. Tour **Gainey Vineyards**; 3950 E. Hwy. 246, Santa Ynez. *Daily tours at 11am, 1pm, 2pm, and 3pm*. 805.688.0558
56. Stroll and window shop along **State Street** in downtown Santa Barbara.
57. Take **East or West Camino Cielo** roads to enjoy incredible views of the coast.
58. Drive along **Foxen Canyon Road** to experience the beauty of the wine country.
59. Ride the **electric shuttle** which runs everyday from Stearns Wharf to State St. 25¢. 805.683.3702
60. Browse through more than 60 satellite stores at **La Cumbre Plaza**; State St. and La Cumbre Rd.
