In 1899 the company bought the Union Brewery holding which included the Houghton site. By the turn of the century the Bosch Brewing Company had brewing facilities in Lake Linden and Houghton, as well as storehouses and branches in Calumet, Laurium, Hancock, Eagle Harbor and Ishpeming.
