## **SEARAILS Historic Depots Model Project**

SEARAILS, the leader in intermodal terminal display models, wants to model your depot as part of a 12 depot model subscription series. Please read the attached letter and answer, in confidence, the attached questionnaire.

No money is required for inclusion in the project. However, this is a commercial venture for SEARAILS, and any level of commitment will be welcome. There is no requirement for purchasing your depot model.

Depots to be modeled will be selected to be included in this project using the following criteria in order of priority;

- A. 501(C)3 status of the depot's sustaining or operating organization. Of course, this automatically includes government agencies and departments.
- B. Level of committed cooperation by the Depot's operator/developer in supplying architectural drawings (Computer Aided Design files or hand drawn plans, elevations, and details).
- C. Architectural interest, style, form, unique features, site, historical significance, logos, graphics and other details provided.
- D. Availability of commercial outlet on site including, but not limited to, gift shop, museum, catalog, and other retail outlets (auctions, premiums, etc.)
- E. Participation in prototype development by the Depot's operating organization and/or an associated model railroad club.

Depots selected will be announced 90 days in advance of their production release. The selection process will be the sole responsibility of SEARAILS.

Candidates for selection will be required to confirm their level of cooperation through the provision of architectural documentation <u>and</u> a legal release of use of any copyright for the purposes of commercial reproduction and sale. That confirmation <u>MUST</u> be received before June 1, 2004. This subscription will be a timed release of models over a three year period. A model release schedule by region (NOT by specific depot) will be announced June 1, 2004.

## **Historic Railroad Depot Models**

On July 1, 2004 SEARAILS announces a subscription of limited production models of twelve historic railroad depots. Each model depot will represent a separate geographic region; New England, Northeast, Mid-Atlantic, Southeast, Mid-South, Mississippi Valley, Great Lakes, Midwest, Rocky Mountain, Southwest, Pacific, Northwest.

100 units of each of the planned limited production depots will be modeled in 1:160 scale (N-Scale). Each depot model's finished architecture and paint scheme will be approved by its local operating sponsor.

10% of first year's local sales, and 2% of first year's national sales of each regional depot model's selling price will be donated to its local non-profit sponsor 501(C)3. Individual Depot prices are expected to range between \$50 and \$100. A new regional depot will be offered each quarter.

The sponsor's minimum commitment is the provision of architectural drawings (preferebly CAD files) for its model's development and packaging artwork.

Each sponsor will be offered all of the individual depot models for resale at a 25% discount, none are obligatory. Any sponsor may sell any depot, and SEARAILS would appreciate each sponsor offering 10 units of its own depot's model for sale in its retail outlet, but this is not obligatory.

We will be selecting the depots to be modeled shortly. If your organization is interested in authorizing a model of its depot for resale, please contact us at your earliest convenience. The first quarterly release in July 2004 will be the Petaluma, CA depot (SP/NWP).
