The SJV Club

The St.Joe Valley Railroad Club is a group of model railroaders who meet on Wednesday and Friday evenings to build and operate a large IIO scale model railroad.

The St. Joe Valley Railroad (or SJV for short) is a 1950's era Appalachian coal hauler that runs north and south from Chattanooga TN to a port on Lake Erie. The SJV also has considerable other industrial and bridge route traffic in addition to long-haul and local passenger runs. The segment we model is from a little south of Pittsburgh PA to just north of Charleston WV.

The SJV uses such modern layout design features as double-deck construction, hidden staging yards at each end of the mainline, and Digital Command Control (DCC). Our mainline is complete and boasts a length of 420' and a large division yard. Three branch lines serve a coal mine, a wharf area, and an industrial district. Our generously wide aisles make operating trains a pleasure. We will be having timetable and train order operations with a dispatcher, fast clocks, and the Old Line Graphics card system. The new SJV will be one of the premier operating layouts in the country--why not join us in building it? Membership is open to modelers of all levels of skill and experience, and dues are very reasonable.

Our club dates back to 1963 when we built a layout in a house next to Bob's Hobby Shop on Main Street in Mishawaka. From 1977 to 1995 we built a large layout in the rear of the Hobbyland store on Lincolnway West in South Bend. You may remember that railroad from the frequent open houses we held in the 1980's and 1990's. That railroad had to be dismantled when the building was sold in March of 1995.

We soon located new club quarters in the summer of 1995 in the historic New York Central freight station on Spring Street in downtown Mishawaka. We began layout construction in 1996 with the goal of making the new SJV bigger and better than the old one.

Beginners and veterans alike are welcome at the SJV. Our projects include tracklaying, wiring/electronics, scenery, structures, motive power, and rolling stock. We invite you to join us at around 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday evenings. We are always happy to show our railroad to visitors. We are easy to find because we are right next to the (now) NS tracks between Spring and Main Streets and directly across the tracks from St. Joseph Hospital. We are at the east end of the freight station but you can enter from either Main or Spring. Why not join us in this best of all hobbies?
