
THE WESTERN NEW YORK RAILWAY HISTORICAL SO-CIETY AND OUR HERITAGE DISCOVERY CENTER WILL BE HOSTING THE BUFFALO & SUSQUEHANNA RAIL-WAY SYMPOSIUM ON AUGUST 3RD & 4TH. THIS IS THIRD IN A SERIES OF SYMPOSIUMS THAT HAVE FO-CUSED ON THE UNIQUE HISTORY OF THE BUFFALO & SUSQUEHANNA RAILROAD.

THIS YEAR'S SYMPOSIUM WILL FOCUS ITS DISCUSSION ON THE RAILROAD'S BUFFALO EXTENSION FROM WELLSVILLE TO BUFFALO, NEW YORK, AS WELL AS EXPLORING THE FAMILY CONNECTIONS OF THE GOOD-YEARS AND THEIR RELATED BUSINESSES.



THE B&S RAILROAD WAS ORIGINALLY FORMED IN 1891 TO TRANSPORT LUMBER FROM THE FORESTS OF NORTHWESTERN PENNSYLVANIA TO MARKETS ACROSS THE COUNTRY. THE GOODYEAR FAMILY BE-GAN TO EXPAND THEIR INDUSTRIAL EMPIRE TO IN-CLUDE A NEW STEEL MILL IN BUFFALO, IRON MINES IN MINNESOTA, AND COAL MINES IN PENNSYLVANIA, AS WELL AS A STEAMSHIP COMPANY ON THE GREAT LAKES.

IN 1906. THE DECISION WAS MADE TO EXTEND THE LINE NORTH TO BUFFALO FROM WELLSVILLE, A DIS-TANCE OF 85 MILES TO PROVIDE DIRECT CONTROL OF THE TRANSPORTATION OF THE COAL AND LUMBER PRODUCTS TO BUFFALO. IT WAS THE LAST MAJOR RAILROAD EXPANSION TO THE BUFFALO RAILROAD HUB. HOWEVER THE STORY OF THIS NEW LINE WAS SHORT-LIVED AS JUST TEN YEARS LATER THE RAIL-ROAD WAS ABANDONED AND SCRAPPED. THE SYMPO-SIUM WILL EXPLORE THE EXTRAORDINARY HISTORY OF THE RAILROAD, THE GOODYEARS AND THEIR INDUSTRI-AL EMPIRE. IT IS OPEN TO ALL INTERESTED IN HISTORY TO ATTEND, AS WELL AS JOINING US ON A SPECIAL BUS AND RAIL TOUR TO EXPLORE THE RAILROAD'S ROUTE TO BUFFALO.

### **BUS & RAIL TOUR**

ON FRIDAY AUGUST 2ND. WE WILL BE HOSTING A COMBINED BUS AND RAIL TOUR OVER THE ARCADE AND ATTICA, BUFFALO SOUTHERN, AND BUFFALO, CATTARAUGUS & JAMESTOWN SCENIC RAILROADS, AS WELL AS VISITING SOME LAST REMAINING VESTIGES OF THE B&S ALONG THE WAY.

OUR EXCURSION WILL START BY BOARDING OUR BUS AT THE HERITAGE DISCOVERY CENTER AT 8AM ON FRIDAY AUGUST 2ND. WE WILL FIRST TRAVEL TO NORTH JAVA, NY WHERE WE WILL BOARD THE AR-CADE & ATTICA RR TRAIN TO TRAVEL THE LENGTH OF THE LINE TO ARCADE JUNCTION, RIDING OVER THE LAST PIECE OF THE B&S RY. OUR TRAIN WILL THEN RETURN TO THE ARCADE DEPOT TO UNLOAD.

BOARDING OUR BUS., WE DEPART ARCADE TO SEE SOME LAST REMAINING STRUCTURES OF THE B&S RY AS WE HEAD OVER TO NORTH COLLINS, NY FOR OUR SECOND TRAIN RIDE OVER THE FORMER ERIE RAIL-ROAD'S BUFFALO & SOUTHWESTERN DIVISION, KNOW OPERATED AS THE BUFFALO SOUTHERN RR.

DEPARTING NORTH COLLINS AT 1:30, OUR TRAIN WILL BE OPERATED BY THE BUFFALO, CATTARAUGUS & JAMESTOWN SCENIC RR AND HEAD NORTH SOME 26 MILES TO BUFFALO JCT, PASSING OVER TRACKAGE ONCE USED BY THE B&S RY.

A BOXED LUNCH WILL BE AVAILABLE TO RESERVE AND EAT ON BOARD THE TRAIN. DEPARTING BUFFALO JCT. WE HEAD SOUTH TO HAMBURG TO MEET OUR BUS TO RETURN TO THE HERITAGE DISCOVERY CENTER, WHERE WE WILL HOST A PICNIC COOKOUT FOR OUR TRAVELERS.

THE COST OF THE BUS & RAIL TOUR WILL BE \$85 PER PERSON AND MUST BE RESERVED IN ADVANCE. AN OPTIONAL BOXED-LUNCH CAN BE RESERVED FOR \$10. IF YOU ONLY WISH TO RIDE THE TRAIN BETWEEN HAMBURG, NORTH COLLINS & BUFFALO JUNCTION, THE TRAIN WILL DEPART HAMBURG AT NOON AND THE COST WILL BE \$38 PER PERSON.


